

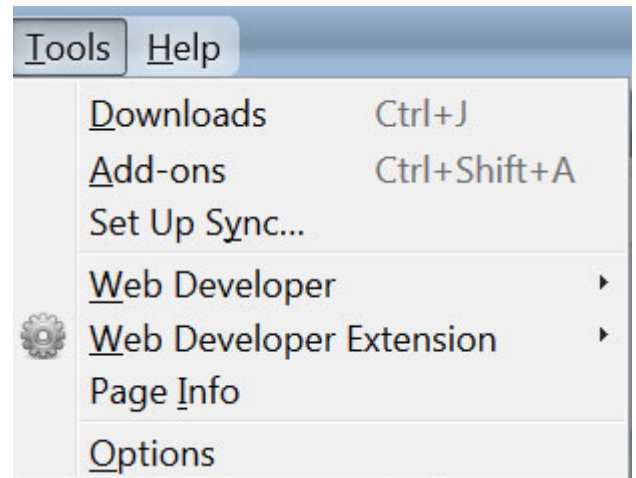
# Import a Digital Certificate to Mozilla Firefox

\*\*\*Note: Users may require Local Administrative Privileges in order to successfully import the certificate.\*\*\*

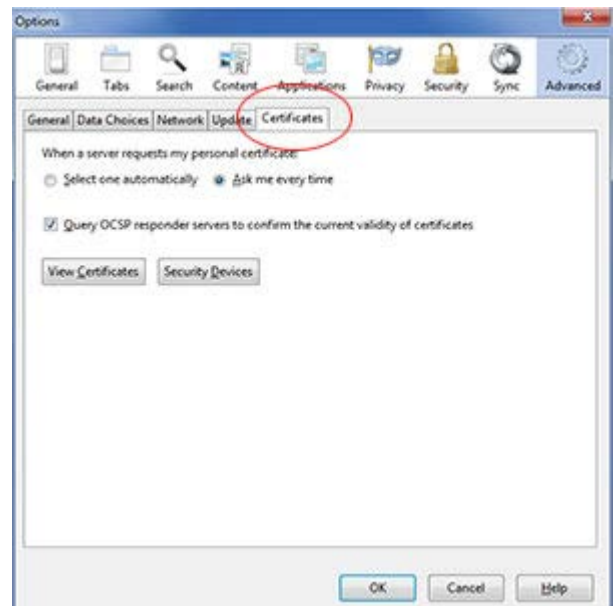
## STEP 1

In the toolbar at the top of the Firefox browser, select **Tools** and then **Options** from the drop down list.



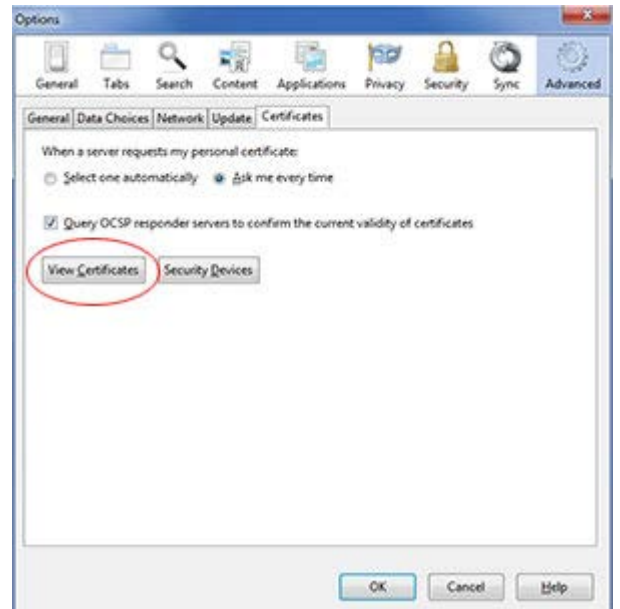
## STEP 2

Click on the **Advanced** icon and then on the **Certificates** tab.



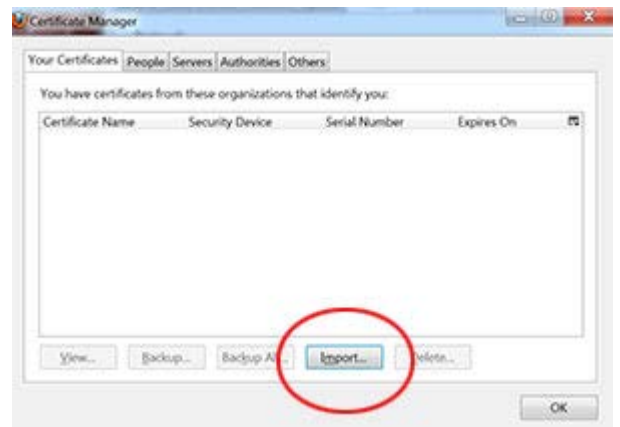
STEP 3

Click on the **View Certificates** button.



STEP 4

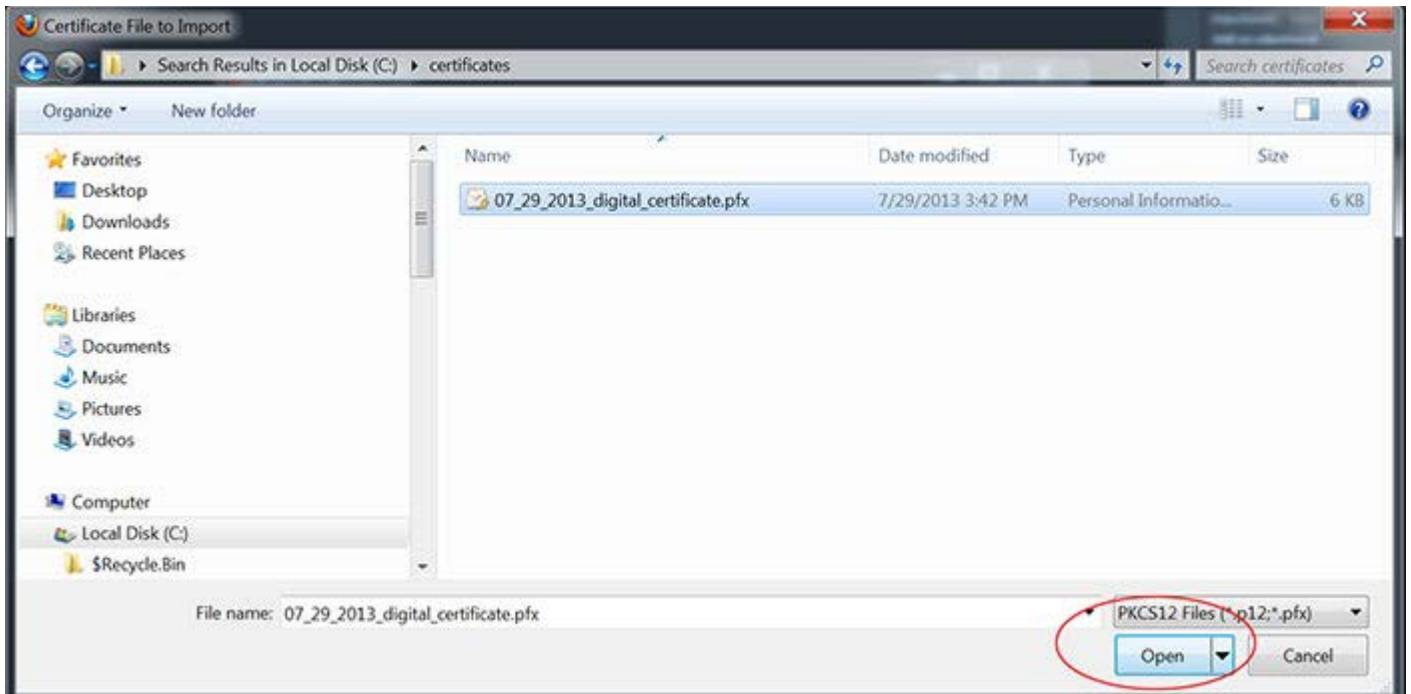
Click the **Import** button.



STEP 5

Navigate to the stored digital certificate location and click on the filename to highlight.

Click the **Open** button.



**STEP 6**

The Password Entry Dialog box will appear. Type the password for the digital certificate and click **OK**.



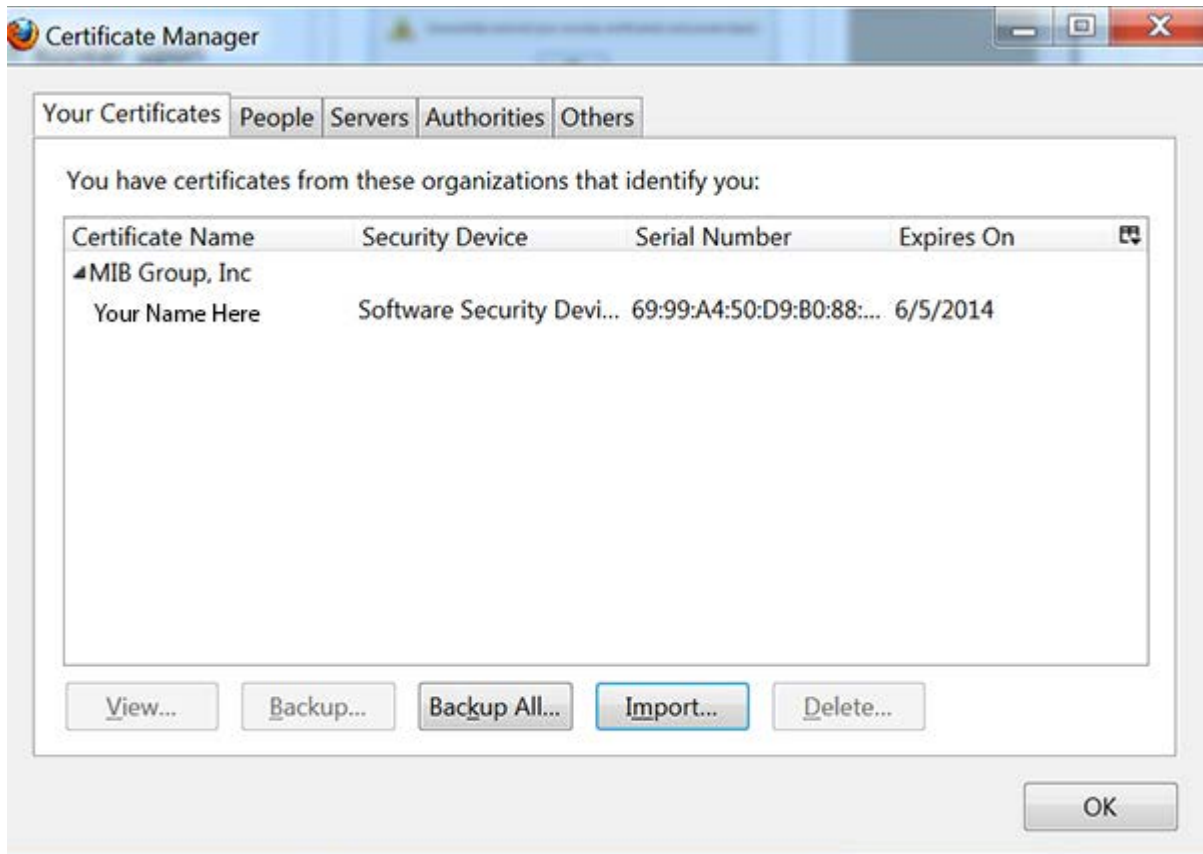
**STEP 7**

An alert box will appear upon successfully restoring your digital certificate. Click **OK**.



**STEP 8**

Your certificates will appear under the **Your Certificates** tab.
